09:00 Welcome to Copenhagen, by Anne Fox

10:00 WP3 Vitae course design document and Business plan for Italy, by Maria and Marco

Business plan:

Possible target groups:

- to offer the Vitae course to public schools Possible.
- to offer the Vitae course to private schools Not possible.
- to offer the Vitae course as a University course or part of study program Possible.

The course is adaptable from 3 - 6 ECTS.

The business plan is based on giving 6 courses per year and 19 % profit.

16 students gives a price of 478 Euro per student.

Comments for the evaluation part. What to ask the course participants in the final survey:

- study hours we recommend.
- study hours they actually used.
- study hours they think they would have needed.
- how much are they available to work.

The Vitae course:



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Online working hours represent a workload of 2,5 times the normal workload.

The course will be adopted to the study group so we need some kind of competence mapping at the beginning of the course.

Italy wants to use the CoP during the course to show what kind of possibilities it gives the students.

Challenges: the technical infrastructure in Italy and how much time the students have to spend.

11:00 WP3 Vitae course design document and Business plan for Portugal, by Jose and Eduardo

Business plan:

We want to make two versions of the course based on two target groups .

A preliminary module, module 1 + 2 and module 3.

In Portugal we can ask for co-financing to make the course cheaper for the participants. This course will not give incomes to CENFIM.

The Vitae course:

Now 12 lectures in total. Course starting 23. April and end 30. June.

Only some parts can be translated, not everything. This assumes some requirements to English skills.

The goal is to find local resources and web tools as much as possible.

The timetable for the target group can be a challenge: the teacher-coach must negotiate the pace with the students, since normally they have full-time works.

Technical aspects concerning eTutors portal: What kind of features can we add from eTutors portal that gives added value to this project? Andrea and Eduardo will figure out how the CoP and the eTutors portal can be used together for the Vita course. One possibility is to transfer some functionality, structure and/or some contents mostly based on external links to technical contents.

Comments from Anne: We have 16 LO in the design document. Originally 15 + 1 new one about coaching. A tip for a resource person in Portugal can be Teresa D'Eça Almeida.

The ECTS credit system is important in Portugal and Norway. Portugal is used to the UFCD credits system that is equivalent to ECTS.

Anne: You can find a helpful resource about coaching in the CoP. But you have to pay for a licence. 100 Euros per coach - It is called coachMaster tool.

11:30 WP3 Vitae course design document and Business plan for Lithuania, by Julita

The Business plan and the Vitae course:

We will be loyal to the original course and make a short course. This is related to the price that is a very important factor in Lithuania. The course will be 6 weeks 7,5 hours work each week.

A blended course - face to face meeting in combination with Skype.

The price is 60 Euro for one student for a blended course. 45-50 Euro for an online course.

The future plan is to give the Vitae course pedagogical points.

Challenges: Technical aspects - LMS system and CoP. What activities will be organised here? Can we do some things in common? The difference in timetable is a challenge here. A solution can be local communities first in the CoP before we do something in common.



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Thorleif: Is it possible to find funding other places than just having course fees?

- Course fees.
- University funding.
- Program for ICT (e.g. budget for further teacher training).
- ECTS when the students pass the exam (kick back funding).
- Cofunding - payment by the government.

12:00 WP3 Vitae course design document and Business plan for Norway, by Bjørn and Thorleif

Business plan:

The business model where presented with these main topics:

Business idea, Personal information, Product/service, Market, Marketing and sales activities, Budget and economy, The need for capital and financing, course organisation and administration, Attachments.

Torhild: We should also add Course designers to the market. They are also important course attendants.

The Vitae course is already in place in the Norwegian portal for selling courses (itfag.hist.no). So it is already open for course participants to enroll.

The course will be run twice a year.

The Vitae course:

We want to adapt our Vitae course to the Norwegian model for online courses.

Based on this model we already have a lot of knowledge about our target group.

The pilot course will be 12 lessons and 6 ECTS. It will be run during 12 weeks in spring 2012.

Challenges: There is a lot of work to do for the preparations, but the practicalities are in place.

14:00 WP5 - Vitae courses, by Julita

First we looked at a summary of what we have done so far concerning the preparations for running the Vitae courses. Things we have to do:

- Prepare the courses before running the courses.
- Formal approval of the course.
- Marketing and recruitment.
- Prepare the LMS (local Moodle) in each country and CoP (in local language or English).
- Involve the administration and teachers.
- A common pretest for the teacher-students and evaluation survey for all the countries for teacher-students and teacher-trainer. Done in English by the end of November. Make a document in Google Docs called "Evaluation of the Vitae pilot course" as input to the pretest.

Things we need for the general business model:

- Who payed the course fee?
- What was your motivation for following this course? etc.

14.45 WP6 - A CoP for VET teachers, by Andrea



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The CoP is based on Elgg and contains a lot of tools (<http://understandit.di.uniroma1.it/>).

We got a demonstration of the user interface and functionality:

- A social community where you can communicate with your friends.
- Contains a timeline for each document to see how it has developed.
- You can share your content with others on a detailed level.
- Can get notifications based on people or groups.
- Everybody will get a user after this meeting for the CoP in UnderstandIT.
- A coachmaster (structured coaching - online version of the GROW coaching model) is also implemented. Link to the product: <http://www.bobgriffiths.com/Coachmaster.html> .

This looks like an impressive system that really contains a lot of functionality.

Andrea need a person to help him translate the last part of the text for the CoP from each country.

Spamming must be reported to Andrea and he will throw them out of the CoP.

How we should start to use it was described in the presentation.

An article in Denmark and one in Norway. A couple of publications in Italy. Please report all kind of activities to Torhild as soon as possible.

We have to update the webpage for the project because it has been the same for to long time at the moment . How can we draw attention to it ? (twitter, blog with reference to the project, CoP). All partners should present UnderstandIT at there own webpages and send the link to Torhild. Spin off effect to the CoP to dissemination activities.

We should make a pamflet for the UnderstandIT.

We will participate in 2 national conferences (Lithuania and Norway-Thorleif Nade conference).

We need publication through papers and presentations (Anne in IATEFL 2012, Somebody in EDEN 2012).

Are we allowed to travel to non partner countries? We have to check.

Should we make a book to present the results from the project. This might give us a problem concerning the resources. So we have to see at the end of the project. For now a book is out of the question because of the funding.

10:20 WP8 - A generic Business model, by José
